Adult Presentations

A 60-minute presentation is available for adult audiences to inform them about essential information regarding the vaping culture that continues to gain popularity with teens. Topics covered include:

- Health and safety concerns of vaping
- Impact of nicotine on the undeveloped, adolescent brain
- Abuse potential of other substances from vaping devices
- Intentional marketing of vaping products to teens and young adults
- What parents can do if they have concerns for their child regarding vaping

Student Presentations

A 40-minute, classroom style, presentation is available for students in grades 6-12 to inform them about the potential dangers and consequences of teenage vaping. Topics covered include:

- Impact of cigarette smoking on previous generations
- Similarities between cigarette smoking and vaping
- Intentional marketing of vaping products to teens and young adults
- Health and safety concerns of vaping
- Impact of nicotine on the undeveloped, adolescent brain
- Options for teens who are addicted to vaping
